DCSF One Children's Workforce model. There will be full feedback and a written record agreed between the teacher and the observer. This information will then be shared with the school.

The team will be led by Francis Loftus. Francis has 33 years experience as a teacher, with 23 of those at Senior Management level. He has just completed 19 years as a Headteacher. He has undertaken a number of roles nationally including being an External Adviser for Headteacher Appraisal and represents the North Yorkshire Secondary Heads as their ASCL representative.
